M.S. "ORIENTAL QUEEN"

With reference to the present Continuous Survey cycles of the hull and machinery, due date for completion September 1964, I shall be glad if you will confirm that definite arrangements have been made by the Owners for these cycles to be completed by the end of September.

I enclose a memorandum giving the items which, according to the records in this Office, appear to be outstanding for the completion of the Continuous Hull Special Survey cycle and would draw your attention to the parts of the hull which have not been surveyed for over four years.

As no period of grace is allowed by the Rules for the completion of Special Surveys carried out on the Continuous Survey basis, the Committee must rely upon the cycle being completed without fail by the due date.

The Owners should also be advised that it is expected that the next Continuous Survey cycle of the hull will be carried out in accordance with the previously approved schedule, a copy of which is attached for their information, so that the interval between the surveys of any tanks and spaces does not exceed four years and approximately 25% of the cycle is carried out during each year, in accordance with the Society's requirements for Continuous Special Surveys (Hull).

A memorandum giving the items ,
according to the records in this Office,
outstanding for the completion of the Continuous
Survey cycle of the machinery is also enclosed.
The items marked X have not been examined for
more than four years.

A Donkey Boiler Survey will become
due at the end of October 1964 and the hull class
is at present continued subject as stated in the
S.R.L. No.220.
