Dear Sir,

I beg to acquaint you that Messrs. Eriksbergs Mek. Verkstads A/B, of this port, have informed us to-day that the rudder casting intended for their Yard No. 292 and manufactured by Messrs. Königlich Ungarische Staatliche Eisen-, Stahl- und Maschinenfabriken at Diösgyör, is ready for testing and inspection, but that it is impossible to obtain the services of the Society's Surveyors stationed at Vienna. They state that the Norske Veritas has a representative who could undertake the testing. I have therefore to-day telegraphed you as follows:-
