The following ventilator coamings have been cut off flush with the vehicle deck and efficient welded doubling plates fitted over the openings.

Starboard side. Two 50" dia. mechanical exhaust vent coamings.

One 15" dia. vent coaming to seamen's wash house.

Two 12" dia. vent to gyro store and exhaust from fan No.10.

Port Side. One 12" dia. inlet vent coaming to fan No.19.

One 15" dia. exhaust vent coaming from lamp room.
