Pontoons "S.Q.9" and "S.Q.10"

I am in receipt of your letter of the 26th October regarding the above ships and note your remarks.

Provided the following equipment, or equivalent, is placed on board each pontoon, the vessels will be eligible to be classed 100A1 "Pontoon":-

2 - 16 cwts. stockless anchors.

105 fathoms of $1\frac{1}{4}$ " diameter stud link cable or $4\frac{3}{4}$ " (6/12) S.W.R.

1 @ 90 fathoms of 3" (6/12) S.W.R. or $6\frac{1}{2}$ " (3 strand) fibre rope.

2 @ 90 fathoms of $1\frac{3}{4}$ " (6/12) S.W.R. or 4" (3 strand) fibre rope.

You should report when the equipment has been placed on board and verified in order that the cases may be submitted to the Committee for assignment of class.
