We write to advise you that the above vessel has recently been withdrawn from service in order to undergo at Hamburg her Boiler Survey, which is due in January 1954 and the Hull part of her Special Survey, which is due in May 1954.

It would best suit the Company's arrangements if the Engine part of this Special Survey were held on the occasion of the vessel's next dry-docking in November 1954, when we would also like to hold the Screw Shaft Survey. We shall, therefore, be glad to learn whether the latter arrangements meet with your approval and that you are agreeable to the postponement to November 1954 of the Screw Shaft Survey, which would otherwise be due in May 1954.
