Portion of Survey held, &c., _____

The 3rd SS. No. 2 due 12.21 has been partly held.

The Naples Surveyors on the 29th August last stated the vessel was laid up at that port sequestrated by the Creditors, ~~who are~~ ^{to} awaiting the Italian Courts order for sale by auction.

The vessel was reported to have sustained damage through fire and to have been beached to prevent sinking.

The case received consideration on the 29th September when action was deferred, subject to the conditions usually required in similar cases. *and the*

The Naples Surveyors were requested to inform the Auctioneers accordingly.

The same Surveyors stated on the 21st November that on the 4th of that month they wrote to the President of the Tribunale and Captain of the Port informing them of the Committee's decision to allow the class of the vessel to remain subject to the Special Survey and Repairs being carried out before the vessel proceeded to sea.

The year of grace expired at the end of December last and the Naples Surveyors now state there are no fresh developments.

It is submitted action might be deferred and the Owners asked to furnish the usual undertaking.
