With reference to your letter of the 17th instant respecting the steamer " PHILADELPHIA " we beg to inform you when we heard the vessel was to be sold by Auction we communicated by registered letters dated the 4th instant, addressed to the President of the Tribunale & Captain of the Port, that the vessels class was subject to the surveys and repairs on the Hull, Machinery & boilers being carried before the vessel proceeds to sea.

Although in your letter it states the machinery survey has been completed, the boilers & machinery of this vessel we are informed are now in a much neglected condition, and in the circumstances connected with this case, we deem it advisable to examine everything before the vessel sails. Consequently we embodied this in our letter to the President of the Tribunale and Captain of the Port.
