
The 3rd S.S. No. 2 due 12.21 has been partly held.

The Naples Surveyors on the 29th August stated the vessel was laid up at that port, sequestered by Creditors, to await the Italian Courts order for sale by auction.

The case received consideration on the 29th September when action was deferred, subject to the conditions usually required in similar cases, and the Naples Surveyors were requested to inform the Auctioneers accordingly.

The same Surveyors now state the vessel sustained little damage through fire, and that she will be sold by auction this month.
