In reply to your letter of the 21st inst. in regard to the surveys due on various vessels owned by Mr. W. Robertson, I beg to acquaint you that the S.S. "TOURMALINE" <sup>Pptn</sup> is now under survey at Port Glasgow where a new boiler is being fitted.

As regards the "RUBY" and "MORION", no arrangements have yet been made in regard to the surveys to which you refer but you will recollect that Mr. Robertson has arranged to lay off the "ONYX" <sup>Pptn</sup> "EMERALD" <sup>Pptn</sup> and "CAIRNGORM" <sup>Pptn</sup> next for survey, and thereafter the "RUBY" and "MORION" will be dealt with.
