COMPANIONWAYS. Now fitted. 1 to aft peak in steel deck house with steel hinged door 5' x 2' operated both sides. Sill 18" (over steel deck).

1 to 3rd class accommodation aft in steel deck house with solid wood doors 5' x 2'3" operated both sides. Sill 18".

1 port and starboard to crew accommodation on aft deck in steel deck houses with solid wood doors, 5'3" x 2'0" operated both sides Sill 10" over wood.

SMALL HATCH. On freeboard deck in forecastle 3'0" x 2'9" x 11" high with covers, tarpaulins and closing appliances.

VENTILATORS. on forecastle deck. 1 to Fore Peak 9" x 18" high
2 to accm. 6" x 18" high
1 to hold 18" x 24" high
fore well 2 @ 12" x 9" high (secured)
6 @ 21" x 24" " with patent cowls
Aft deck 2 @ 12" x 7'6" (protected)
4 " 21" x 24" high
2 @ 12" x 27" high to crew spaces
1 @ 14" x 48" high to hold
2 @ 18" x 24" high

CARGO DOORS. 3 port and starboard vice 1 P & S

BUNKER HATCH ON BRIDGE DECK. 10'5" x 15'11" x 27" high 1 beam 19" x .34" with double angles 3 x 3 x .40 complete battening arrangements.
