Dear Sir,

With reference to the Glasgow First Entry Report  
No. 35880 on the new twin-screw steamer "AVENGER" and to the  
letter forwarded by Mr. Shaw from the Superintendent for the  
Union Steamship Co. of New Zealand, it is noted that the  
intermediate tween deck bulkhead will be fitted when the vessel  
is returned to the Builders for re-conditioning, also that  
suitable structural compensation for the omission of this  
bulkhead has been provided in the form of a screen bulkhead.

The case has received the consideration of the  
General Committee at their Meeting to-day, and I am directed  
to inform you that in the circumstances the proposals will  
be approved, subject to a notation being made in the Society's  
Register Book, as follows: "1 Tween deck B.H. dispensed with,  
1 B.H. to Shelter Deck, 7 B.H. to Upper Deck, 3 B.H. to Second Deck  
only".
