Loeffler Boiler Installation.

E. With reference to the last paragraph of my letter of the 20th instant relative to the above installation, I beg to inform you that the plans of valves will be approved for a working pressure of 130 kg. per sq. cm. and temperatures as shown on the plans, but in no case exceeding 475°C, provided the stud bolts and nuts securing the covers of steam valves be made of Ni-Cr-Mo steel where now indicated on the plans, and provided the work be to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors.

Thirteen copies of the plans forwarded by your goodselfs have been sent to you to-day under separate cover, and I shall be obliged if you will kindly transmit these plans, after noting, to the Society's Surveyors at Vienna, for their guidance. I should add that the remaining copies of the plans are being retained in this Office, for reference purposes.

I take this opportunity of confirming my telegram of to-day, reading as follows:-
