I duly received your letter of the 23rd ultimo advising plans, in triplicate, in respect of the above installation, and have to acquaint you that the amended plan of evaporator drum will be approved for a working pressure of 140 kg. per sq. cm., provided the drum be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing and to your satisfaction.

It is noted that the minimum ultimate tensile strength of the steel will be 55 kg. per sq. mm., and I have to add that the range of tensile strength should not exceed 6 kg. per sq. mm.

Two copies of the amended plan are being returned under separate cover, and the plan approved on the 17th July last should be cancelled.

With reference to the plans of 50 mm. and 6 mm. valves (plans Nos. 2480/H and 2476/H), I have to acquaint you that these plans were approved in my letter of the 24th instant to Messrs.
