Conte Rosso

Loeffler Boiler and Escher Wyss Turbine Installation

Mr Wiesendanger, the London Manager of Messrs Escher Wyss Engineering works called at this office ^{today} and presented two copies of letters from firms which had been supplied with turbine casings of pearlitic cast iron, which have been subjected to superheated steam at temperatures in excess of $300^{\circ}\text{C} = 572^{\circ}\text{F}$.

express the firms satisfaction with these turbine casings which have been in use for 5 and 14 years respectively.

Mr Wiesendanger was asked to provide a further letter from Messrs Outreau, from whom a letter is expected, and this further information is awaited.

This gentleman was also reminded that Mr Platt, who called at this office on the 13th December 1936, promised to send to this office the results of Laboratory experiments carried out on this material, if these were still available.
