I am in receipt of your letter of the 28th ultimo respecting the Loeffler Boiler & Escher Wyss Turbine Installation for the s.s. "CONTE ROSSO", from which I note that it is now proposed to fit studs of Chrome Nickel Molybdenum Steel to the manoeuvring valve and that the nuts are to be of mild steel of medium hardness.

I have to inform you, however, it is considered that the nuts also should be made of a special heat resisting steel, for the reasons given in my letters of the 6th, 20th and 24th September last addressed to Messrs. Witkowitz Mines, Steel & Iron Works Corporation, copies of which were forwarded to you.
