With reference to the First Entry Report No. 42003 on the Steamer "TYRRHENIA", I beg to acquaint you that the Surveyor states that the ^{deck} "C"/strake of shell plating is doubled at the after break and the thickness and riveting of this strake at the forward break are as approved.

As regards the machinery, the Surveyor also states that the spare gear is in accordance with the requirements of the Rules, and a complete list will be forwarded as soon as received from the Builders.
