Dear Mr. Warlow,

You will notice that we are sending you down officially to-day the First Entry Certificates for the new Cunard Steamer "TYRRHENIA".

Unfortunately I find at the last moment that a mistake has been made in entering the date of build, so that an erasure appears on the certificate.

In the ordinary way I should not allow such a certificate to be issued, but as it is quite impossible to prepare a fresh one tonight, I think it best to send it down with the promise that a fresh one shall be made tomorrow and sent to you, so that it may be exchanged, as it is of course of importance that the permanent certificate should have no erasure upon it.

I trust that the adoption of this course will avoid any inconvenience to the Builders or Owners.
