The class is subject to indented shell plating, port side abreast the foremast, being dealt with at the Owners' convenience, and to the rudder post of the stern frame, E.W. repair 4,39 and previously, being specially examined at the next drydocking.

The Manchester Surveyors now report the vessel examined afloat after striking a submerged object; soundings taken and no signs of leakage found.

Some minor wear and tear repairs have been effected.

The Surveyors recommend further examination at the next drydocking.

It is submitted action be deferred.
