

Messrs. Muir & Findlay attend at their Works at Parkhead for the purpose of inspecting and witnessing hydraulic test on One Lighting up Heater intended for Messrs. A. Stephen & Sons, Ltd. No. 499. The Heater has been built according to approved plan and the Rules of the Society for a working pressure of 100 lbs per square inch and the materials and workmanship are good. The Heater having been tested in my presence on the 4th of January, 1923, by hydraulic pressure to 200 lbs per square inch showed no sign of weakness and was found tight and sound in every respect at that pressure. Working pressure not to exceed One hundred lbs per square inch.
