Dear Sir,

In reply to the classing letter of the 18th instant respecting Dublin Report N^o 7056 on the s.s. "Finola" I beg to inform you that the weights of the Cast Steel heads of the 1st & 2nd bower anchors including the weight of the accessories are estimated to be equivalent to $\frac{3}{5}$ ths of the total weight of the anchors.

The bulk head at frame N^o 61 is specially stiffened in way of the large brackets supporting the deck as approved.

The breadth of the butt laps of the fore-castle side plating is $7\frac{1}{4}$ " as stated, the diameter and pitch of the rivets being $\frac{5}{8}$ " & $2\frac{1}{4}$ " & $2\frac{1}{4}$ " and $2\frac{5}{8}$ " as stated.
