Dear Sir,

The Ramsey S.S.Co. have written to me about the case of their "BEN VOOR", which is due for Special Survey this month, and her Load Line Certificate expires on the 27th of this month.

In view of the age of the ship, they do not wish to put her through another Special Survey, but would, nevertheless, like to continue trading until the spring of next year. They, therefore, wish to apply for an extension of the Freeboard Certificate and for the vessel's class to be continued for the time proposed.

The vessel was in dry dock on the Clyde last year when a new screwsaft was fitted and again dry docked in Liverpool for collision repairs as recently as January this year. The Owners, therefore, hope that if the Committee are good enough to grant their request and in that connection call for a General Examination, they will not require that this should take place in dry dock.
