I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 24th inst., along with my report No. 12206 on the new steamer "Adelaide" calling attention to a few slips and omissions which have been made by me in this Report.

I have to state that the Keel plate buttstraps are .74 and .68 of an inch and that the thicknesses of the top angles on the Centre girder is .52 on an inch as fitted in the vessel.

I have made the necessary corrections, and return herewith enclosed the Report.
