With regard to the 2 main and 1 auxiliary air compressors which are driven by the main and auxiliary generator engines respectively.


We enclose First Entry Reports in respect of the Sterk Diesel Engines and Bureau Veritas certificates in respect of the compressors.

The Central Marine Engine Works have been in communication with Messrs. Sterk & Co. with regard to the requirements for the torsional vibration characteristics as requested in your letter of 2nd June, 1949, but to date have received no reply.

We might add that during the course of installation the air compressors were opened up, found to be in good condition, and were subsequently tried under working conditions and found satisfactory.
