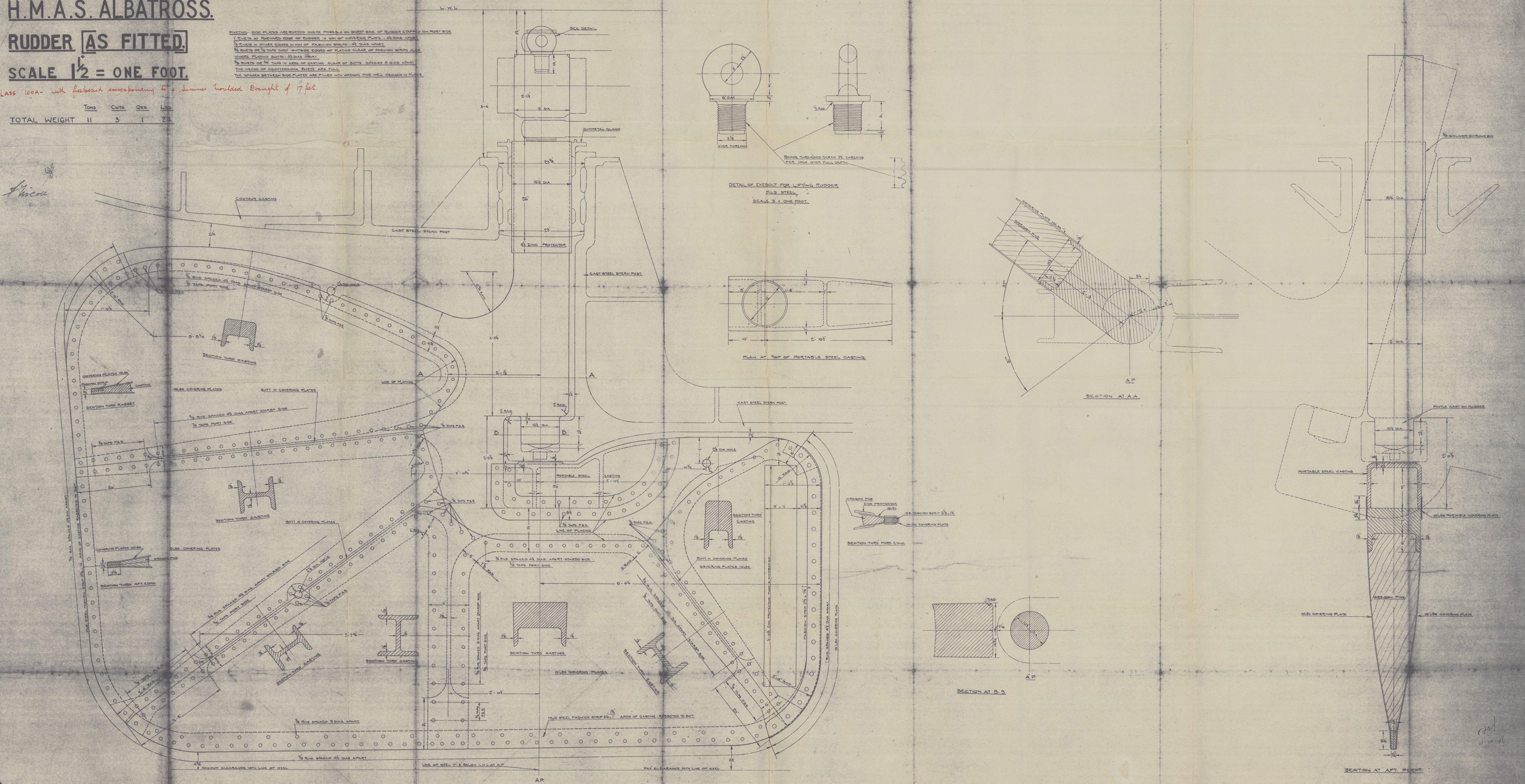

RYETING- SIDE PLATES ARE RIVETED WHERE POSSIBLE ON STARBOARD SIDE OF RUDDER STAFFED ON PORT SIDE
1. RIVETS AT FORWARD EDGE OF RUDDER IN WAY OF COVERING PLATE - 4 1/2 INCHES APART
2. RIVETS IN OTHER EDGES IN WAY OF FASHION STRIPS - 4 1/2 INCHES APART
3. RIVETS ON 1/8 INCH TAPED BUTT JOINTS EDGES OF PLATING CLEAR OF FASHION STRIPS AND
WHERE PLATING BUTT - 4 1/2 INCHES APART
4. RIVETS ON 1/8 INCH TAPED BUTT JOINTS EDGES OF PLATING CLEAR OF FASHION STRIPS AND
WHERE PLATING BUTT - 4 1/2 INCHES APART
THE HEADS OF COUNTERSINK RIVETS ARE FLAT
THE SPACES BETWEEN SIDE PLATES ARE FILLED WITH GREEN PINE WELL WEDGED IN PLACE

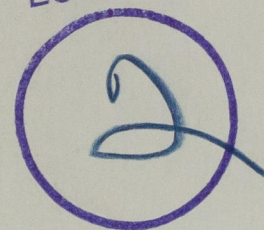
