
With reference to the enquiry contained in the postscript to the Secretary's letter dated the 3rd instant enclosing the freeboard certificates for the s.s. "FELSPAR", I beg to state that four additional freeing ports 2'6" x 1'3½", 10½" above the deck and fitted with one bar, were cut in the raised quarter deck bulwarks on each side.

The distances from the bridge bulkhead to the forward edges of these additional ports are as follows:

23'6": 45'0": 71'6": 100'0".
