With reference to your letter of the 19th ultimo and in confirmation of telephone conversation this morning I have to inform you that there is no information in this Office regarding timber fittings on board the ship and that it cannot be ascertained from the plans if the vessel has the necessary longitudinal subdivision of the double bottom as the plans are very sketchy.

It will therefore be necessary for you to ascertain these particulars by inspection at the ship. You should note that a ship may carry timber deck cargoes although she is not marked with timber deck cargo freeboards.

You should inform this Office if the forecastle has a steel bulkhead fitted with a hinged steel door.
