ACTION and NOTATION of s.s. Kel 4,50 is deferred until 4,51 for completion of SPECIAL SURVEY by repairs to floors, etc.

A PERIODICAL SPECIAL SURVEY (C) due 10,49 was commenced 10,49 and advanced 4,50 Kel.

The K I E L Surveyors report this whaler placed in dry dock, bottom coated and the SPECIAL SURVEY completed by extensive repairs and/or renewals to D.B. and F.P. tank structure as above.

Approx. 1500 scattered defective bottom and side shell rivets dealt with and a number of other minor repairs effected.

Alterations carried out in factory space aft entailing fitting of stiffening in way of new machine installations.

IT IS SUBMITTED the vessel is eligible to remain as classed with record of docking survey 3,51 and to have the notation of s.s. Kel.4,50 assigned as recommended.
