As promised we herewith enclose (in duplicate), the undernoted plans for above vessel, and which embody all amendments to date. We shall be glad to hear as early as possible that the plans now have your final approval.

In considering these plans we would draw your attention to the following points.

Bulkheads Nos. 27 & 73:- It is not practicable to fit a buttress in line with the centre line bulkhead, as in the case of No. 27 it would obstruct the hatch, and in the case of No. 73 would come forward of the shafting. *foul*

Bulkhead No. 27:- Owing to the reduced width of this bulkhead, we have substituted reverse bars on certain of the stiffeners in lieu of fitting the full number of web frames.

After Oil Tank:- Owing to the reduced length of this tank, we propose to fit one web frame only, instead of two.

bulkhead.

Lead No.162:- do. do. do.

With regard to the buttress webs on bulkheads,
I note that we have increased the width of web slightly ^{at} to bottom,
I propose to omit the small bracket ^{there} shown on original approved drawing.

Regarding the omission of the two watertight bulk-
heads in the tween deck, we have written to the Owner asking to let
me have a letter authorising this, but as he is presently in Norway
several weeks may elapse before this letter will be received. The
owners, however, have promised to send it as soon as possible.
