I am in receipt of your letter of the 14th instant respecting the Steamer "ASCANIA" and have to say that as the fresh water is to be used for washing purposes only no exception will be taken to the double bottom tank in way being used for oil fuel.

It is observed you make no remarks regarding the pumping arrangements, but as stated in my letter of the 13th ultimo, it is concluded they will be such that contamination of the fresh water is impossible.
