We enclose herewith an outline sketch of a proposal to convert the Deep Tank of the T.S.S. "ASCANIA" into four Fresh Water Tanks which is necessary to fit the vessel for duty as a troopship.

Structural plans of the new bulkheads will be submitted in due time, but we shall be glad to know if it will be necessary to fit wash-boards as required by the Rules - the width of the tanks being approximately



We understand that the tanks will not be used partially filled. The proposal being that when sufficient capacity in the Double Bottom is available to take the whole of the water from either of two tanks only then it be transferred.
