REMARKS.

The freeboard certificates of this vessel under the Load Line Conventions Act 1932 expire in November, 1933, but the Owners desire the certificates to be renewed from this month as the S.S. No. 3 will be completed on the 11th instant.

In this connection we would refer you to a copy of a letter received from the Owners on the 20th April, 1932 which we forwarded you with our letter of the 21st April, 1932, requesting that the date of the special survey might be postponed until the survey was completed. Your reply dated the 27th April, 1932, stated that their request would receive consideration when the survey was completed. The special survey on the hull which includes drydocking at this time will be completed on the 11th instant, together with the full LMC, and we shall recommend that the survey might be counted from now.

These details are given for your guidance, as we shall require to re-issue the certificates by the 11th inst., as the vessel is due to sail on that date, and our report cannot be made out until afterwards.
