With reference to the freeboard survey report No. 18151 of the s.s. "LANRICK", we now wish to state as follows:-

1. Lifelines have now been fitted in the forward well port and starboard.
2. A centre tee bar support has now been fitted at the centre of the alleyway openings to the after bulkhead of the bridge supporting the weather boards.
3. With regard to the bunker hatch this is a trunkway from the bridge deck and is in accordance with the requirements for the Convention.
