Dear sir,

We enclose herewith freeboard verification form for the s.s. "LANRICK", and we shall be glad to have the certificate and certified copy by return, as the vessel sails on Tuesday the 12th instant.

The Owners desire that the Fresh Water, Summer, and Winter marks only should appear on the vessel's sides. These marks were found on verification, to be cut in, the other marks Tropical Fresh Water, Tropical, and Winter North Atlantic, only being temporarily marked. If the Convention requires that all marks should appear, these latter will be cut in also. It is assumed that the certificate will give particulars of all the marks, and we shall be glad to know for the information of the Owners if their wishes, in this matter, meet the Convention requirements.
