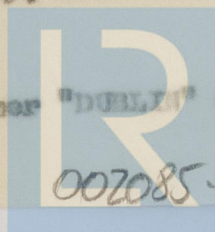
Dear Sirs,

F. I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 4th instant regarding the freeboard certificates of your steamers "CASTLEHILL", "DONAGHMORE", "DUBLIN" and "EVELEEN" and to state that examination has been made of these cases with a view to meeting your wishes as far as possible.

As desired I have the pleasure to enclose a new freeboard certificate and certified copy for the steamer "DONAGHMORE" valid for five years from the recorded date of the last Special Survey, viz:- 31st January, 1933. I think it well to point out, however, that the Annual Freeboard Survey will become due on this vessel on the 20th January next.

With regard to the cases of the steamers "CASTLEHILL" and "EVELEEN" new certificates valid for five years from the recorded date of the last Special Survey will be issued when the Annual Surveys due 28th February, 1934 and 15th September, 1933 respectively are completed.

In the case of the steamer "DUBLIN" the 3rd Special



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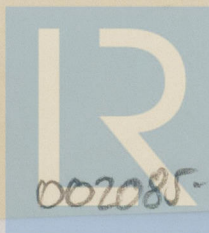
Survey No.1 was not completed in July, 1933; but on completion of this survey new freeboard certificate will be issued for the full period of five years.
