
Enclosed please find verification form of freeboard as now marked on the sides of the steamer "GUNHILD" of Malmø as per assignment letter of the 19th April 09.

The front bridge bulkhead has been additionally strengthened as approved in your letter of the 3rd May 1909, by reverse angle 4" x 4" x 10/20" fitted to each angle stiffener.

The old steel fore and afters replaced by wood fore and afters in all hatches, centre fore and afters 8" x 7" and side fore and afters 7" x 6" with iron plates fitted at ends.
