I beg to state that the Danish Motorvessel "Fionia" classed with your society has been assigned freeboard by the Danish Government in accordance with the International Load Line Convention, 1930, as follows:

Freeboard:

Tropical	T:	1676 mm	5'-6"	} as before 1930
Summer	S:	1803 mm	5'-11"	
Winter	V:	1943 mm	6'-4 1/2"	

Allowance for fresh water for all freeboards: 152 mm 6"
