REMARKS.

No material alterations have taken place in the hull and
superstructure of the vessel which affect the calculation
of freeboards. The fittings and appliances for the protection
of openings, guard rails, freeing ports and means of access to
crew's quarters are in a good condition.

Bridge, After bulkhead:— Hinged wood doors.
Bridge, Forward bulkhead:— No opening.
Forecastle bulkhead:— Hinged steel doors.
