Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was ~~surveyed~~ ^{measured} for assignment of ~~Load Lines~~ ^{Freeboard} in January 1947.

An extra hatchway fitted on Port side of Freeboard deck, within the Bridge Space.

Size:- 2'-7" x 2'-6" x .36" steel plate and 36" high.

2. ⁵/₈" wood hatch covers are fitted, 2 Tarpaulins supplied complete with battens wedges and cleats.

Locking bars also provided for this hatchway and the other two within this space.

The air pipe to No.1 D.B. tank which was at after end of tank now transferred to forward end and the goose neck which is 24" high is situated within the recess in the Forecastle. A suitable canvas cover is supplied.

Instead of hinged storm covers over the Fiddle gratings, portable steel covers have been fitted and are attached to suitable chains.
