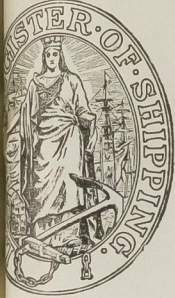

class being dealt with as previously recommended.

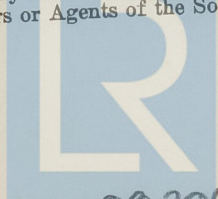
