Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 22nd instant regarding the fee of £105 which has been charged for the survey of the alterations carried out to the Oil Tanker "CLYDEFIELD", as per Nwc. Rpt. 92839, I have to inform you that the request which has been made by Messrs. Smiths Dock Co., Ltd., for some modification of this fee to be made, has been under consideration today.

The reason for Messrs. Smiths Dock Co., putting the matter forward has been carefully noted, and in the circumstances mentioned it has been decided to reduce the fee of £105 to £75 in this instance.

You will therefore be good enough to inform Messrs. Smiths Dock Co., Ltd., accordingly and render an amended account, making the necessary amended cancelling entry in your Rough Fee Book.

I have to add that it would be well in future similar cases where fees have to be paid by Repairers in accordance with their contract, for an amount to be agreed upon in the first instance.


