My Dear Davies,

Your letter of the 22nd instant, which was opened in my absence on Saturday regarding the fees charged for the survey of the alterations carried out to the Oil Tanker "CLYDEFIELD", was brought to my notice today, and as from the statement in the last paragraph, the matter seems to be urgent, I thought it well to make your letter official so that I can send you a reply today.

The facts have been carefully considered and brought to the notice of the Chairman and the Chairman of the Classification Committee today, who conclude that there was no definite figure fixed between you and the Repairers before the work started.

They think that this would have been the best way to have avoided any question after the work had been completed but as they do not wish to appear too arbitrary and it being understood from your letter that a reduced fee of £75 will be satisfactory, they have agreed to the suggestion contained in your letter, but I am writing you officially so as to keep the matter in order.
