I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter  
M. of the 23rd instant respecting the proposed lengthening of the  
M.V. "CLYDEFIELD" by 30'-6", and in reply thereto I have to  
acquaint you that up to the present the only Contractors who  
have submitted proposals to this Office are Messrs. Cammell  
Laird & Co., Ltd., and Messrs. Smith's Dock Co., Ltd., and their  
proposals have received the approval of the Committee.  
These Builders have also been informed that some increase  
would be required to the present equipment and that the increase  
in length would involve a reduction of about 6 inches in the  
existing draught.

I may say it is considered that the alterations  
will not impair the general structural efficiency of the ship  
in any way.
