We have a proposal before us to lengthen the above-named vessel by approximately 30 ft., by the introduction of a new cargo tank between Nos. 4 and 5 or 5 and 6 of the existing tanks.

This work has been put out for tender, and the Contractors instructed that the scheme must have the full approval of your Society, and the alterations carried out to the approval of the Society's Surveyors.

The Contractors when submitting their tenders assured me that full approval has been obtained, and I shall be glad therefore if you will confirm this direct, at the same time indicating that the proposed alterations would not impair the general structural efficiency of the ship in any way.
