I beg to return herewith one copy of the plan, forwarded with your letter of the 30th ultimo, shewing additional freeing port area proposed for the M.V. "CLYDEFIELD", and with regard thereto I have pleasure in stating that the freeing port area as proposed will meet the requirements of the International Loadline Convention.

It has been assumed that the ports 1'-3" square at the fore end of the poop and bridge are freeing ports as stated, and not mooring pipes.

The duplicate plan is being retained for record.
