Dear Sir,

With reference to Glasgow report No.47908 on the freeboard of the s.s. "CLYDEFIELD", Messrs. D. & W. Henderson & Co's No.808M, I shall be glad if the Surveyor will forward the estimated under-deck tonnage calculated to a standard depth of frame, viz:-  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ", and a standard height of floor, viz:- 34", assuming ordinary sparring and ceiling to be fitted, and the floors to have the usual rise so that the bottom breadth of the transverse areas will be about twelve inches, or alternatively the moulded displacement at a moulded draught equal to 85% of the moulded depth.

I shall also be glad if the Surveyor will give particulars of the means for draining the erections.

The two plans forwarded are being retained in this Office in the meantime.
