REEBOARD REPORT on the

S. S. "Clydefield"

It is submitted that the Surveyor be requested to forward the estimated under-deck tonnage calculated to a standard depth of frame, viz $6\frac{1}{2}$ " and a standard height of floors, viz 34 ", assuming ordinary spanning and ceiling to be fitted and the floors to have the usual rise of plating, so that the bottom breadth of the transverse areas will be about 12 inches or alternatively the moulded displacement at a moulded draught equal to 85% of the moulded depth.

The Surveyor should also give particulars of the means for draining the erections.
