Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 17th instant and a letter from Messrs. Swan Hunter & Wigham Richardson, Ltd., regarding the fees for the Special Survey during construction of the S.S. "VANELLUS", we beg to inform you that the vessel was practically completed at the end of last year.

Five visits were paid on the 5th, 6th, 8th, 10th, and 11th January, in connection with the assignment of freeboard and verification of the marking of same, and hosing a small portion of the shelter deck in way of cranes.

The completion of the vessel was undoubtedly delayed until this year in consequence of the joiners strike, and we are of the opinion that this is a case where the Builders have reasonable grounds for requesting that the fee should be charged on the old scale.

The Builders letter is enclosed.
