It is submitted the Liverpool Office be informed in confirmation of today's telephone message that a freeboard corresponding to an all-seasons extreme draught of 25' 0" be assigned, subject to all sidescuttles, the sills of which are less than 6" above the Load Line corresponding to the centre of disc are permanently closed, and all overhead scuppers and sanitary discharges, the inboard ends of which are situated in spaces below the freeboard deck, being provided with screwdown automatic nonreturn valves controlled from the Freeboard deck with indications ^{or} ~~ions~~ to show whether they are open or closed. The scantlings of the vessel are such that a draught in excess of 25 feet could be assigned if so required. The Liverpool Office should advise this Office if assignment is desired.
