

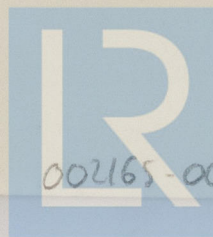
Extract from the Rotterdam Classing Letter dated 19*/1/54.

37133 "ELISABETTA D". As recommended, except that a notation of LMC 11,53 has been assigned and as this notation includes the Boiler Survey no BS record has been assigned.

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 16th instant, and the class of the ship has now been amended to 100A1 "Carrying petroleum in bulk".

37158 "LISBETH M". This ship has to-day been classed *100A1 together with the appropriate notations recommended by you. I shall be glad to receive your confirmation of the following points:-

- 1) that the length of the forecastle as measured in accordance with the "Instructions to Surveyors" is 31' and not 23.4' as reported,
- 2) that the bracket floors at the middleline and at the margin are 7,5 and 8 mm respectively as shown on the "as built" Midship Section and not as reported,
- 3) that "PERBITE" is an approved composition.
