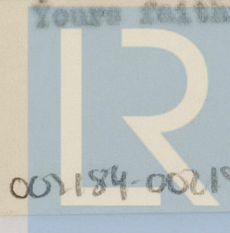
With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the Anglo Saxon Petroleum Co's Curacao Steamers, I am directed to send herewith for your information a copy of a letter which has today been addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Rotterdam in regard to the twenty vessels named therein, and to request that you will be so good as to carefully note the contents.

When you receive in due course the Dutch assignment letters from the Society's Surveyors at Rotterdam, you should arrange for the freeboard markings of these vessels to be ascended. You should then endorse the Dutch assignment letters "Freeboards verified and found correct", sign and date them, and return them, together with the usual verification of marking form to Mr. Leeuwenburg, the Society's Principal Surveyor at Rotterdam, in order that Dutch freeboard certificates may be issued. You should also forward copies of the verification of marking forms to this Office, and the original freeboard certificates should also be returned to this Office for cancellation. The usual revision fee should be charged in each case.
